You will be staying and camping in our main school camp on private land in the foothills of the Anaconda Pintlar Wilderness in Montana. It consists of wall tents with cots and a wood stove. Bring a sleeping bag. There is no electricity or running water. But, there is a gravity feed shower system and outhouses.

If you don't want to stay at camp, we are 17 miles from town and you may stay in a motel in Philipsburg and drive to and from camp every morning and evening. We can give recommendations of motels.

If you are flying.....fly into Missoula, MT (mso) the evening before and get a motel room. We recommend Ruby's Inn and Convention Center (800-221-2057). There is an airport shuttle and breakfast buffet. You can rent a vehicle in Missoula and drive yourself to camp. I will let you know how to get there. If you stay at Ruby's Inn, there is a discount when renting a car from the local car agency.

If you are driving.....please let us know and we will furnish you driving maps and/or instructions to camp.

All guests.....please arrive by 10:00 am the morning of the first day.

IMPORTANT.....If you are going to fish, then you must purchase a fishing license. This cost is not included in the price of the camp because we cannot purchase this license for you. You may purchase a fishing license or find out more information on the Montana Fish and Game Website.
